## Access and parking

Visitor parking bays are available to facilitate your arrival.

They are indicated on the following signs : 

**P** Make sure you go through reception to inform us of your arrival. You will be asked to sign in. Then you will be issued with a visitor badge that you will be required to wear in a visible manner. The badge will need to be handed back on departure.

## General instructions

A smoking area is located outside the main entrance. Please ensure that your cigarette is extinguished and dispose of it using one of the ashtrays provided.

## Going around the premises



You must be accompanied by your GYS guide when going from one part of the company to another. Taking pictures is not allowed unless directly authorised by a senior manager.

### In the offices :

Respect the working environment and the personnel.

### In the factory :

Wearing protective equipment (PPE) is required in certain areas. This will be supplied and adapted to your needs.



When going around the factory, be mindful of the potential risks and pay attention to your environment and the people around you. Forklifts are in constant operation in the warehouse. It is important to pay attention to the vehicles and forklifts passing by in order to avoid any incident. Follow the yellow lines on the floor. If there are none, walk on the side of the paths and not in the middle.

You must not enter the work stations unless prompted to do so. Similarly, you must not touch the various equipment without authorisation as there are risks of electrocution, cuts, burns to you or of electrostatic discharges (ESD) to the products.
